MEASUREMENT REQUIREMENTS

All dogs must have a valid Agility Height Card issued by AKC or be measured prior to any runs (except dogs jumping at the 24" height) at a trial or group of trials. Ms. Karen Wlodarski has graciously agreed to serve as a VMO, in addition to one of our judges, Mr. Blair Kelly. Any entered dog needing an official measurement is required to be measured. It is suggested that you come early morning while courses are being set to be measured. Being measured prior to your run is the responsibility of the exhibitors.

VOLUNTEERS
