AKC Delegate's Report

The Delegate Meeting was held on June 8, 2021, via zoom meeting.

Two amendments were adopted.

- Article VII, New Section2, of the Charter and Bylaws of the AKC, which moves an issue concerning the election of Board members from Article VIII, which addresses the nominating committee, and nominations for the Board, to Article VII which addresses the election of the board members. The remaining sections of Article VII will be renumbered.
- Chapter 16, Section 6, of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows-Championships, removes the phrase referencing one type of independent specialty to generalize the language, provides consistency within the section and allows for future inclusion of additional independent specialties that may be developed without further modification of the section.

President Dennis Sprung gave his report. He presented a wonderful pictorial video looking back on the history of AKC. It can be shown at club meetings. It was so well received by all the Delegates.

For the second week in a row, since the pandemic no All-Breed Shows were cancelled. WELCOME BACK AKC! Only 23% cancelled compared to 2019. Conformation is trending upward. Specialty Shows are at 108% as compared to 2019. AB Group shows are at 97% of 2019.

Fast Cat 177%, Herding Trials 114%, Scent work 113%, Specialty Shows 108%, Agility 105%

Performance Events at 107%, Companion Events 103%, Conformation-Obedience 98%

Registration continues to remain strong. Dog registrations up 38.8%, Litters up 21.9%. 2021 entries are down 29.17% but improving. Total revenues are up, expenses 9.2% under budget. Top revenues sources are Registration, Merchandise sales, Good Dog Help Line, Advertising and Sponsorship.

AKC has established a new role of Junior Coordinator for every club and this position was approved by the AKC BOD. It is recommended that every club consider filling this position. Their job will be to serve as the contact person for all Junior development. Coordinate Junior activities for the club, encourage Junior members to participate in club events, coordinate hosting Junior Showcase event. A full list of the job description can be found on the AKC website.

AKC ReUnite has just announced a new and exciting initiative, <u>Help My Pet ID Card</u>. Not only can this card help to prove ownership, it also offers so much more! If you become ill or injured, your Pet ID Card also alerts first responders to call AKC Reunite so we can initiate your Back Up Plan-to help ensure your pet in not left in a situation without the care they need. Plus, you will receive 3 emergency key fobs to share with other members of your family. All this information is linked to your pet's microchip number. Go to the AKC Reunite website for more information and how to activate your Backup Plan.

As a member of the Detection Dog Task Force, I am very happy to report that two dogs from our Patriotic Puppy Program have been placed as working detection dogs with the Ellsworth Police Department and the Maine Fish and Wildlife Department. More puppies are in training and doing well. More interest in being generated to place American Bred pure-bred dogs in organizations that employ these canine partners who will serve to protect our country and the American people.

Meet The Breeds hits the road! Two-day breed showcases will be held in multiple cities in 2021 with additional dates and locations to be announced later this year. Tickets on sale now for San Diego and Dallas, Texas. This is in conjunction with GF Sports and Entertainment. Visit akc.org/meetthebreeds for more information. SeatGeek will be the official ticketing provider of this national tour.

AKC Board meetings have been meeting via zoom format over the past year. Planning in under way for in person meeting beginning in August 2021. AKC is also planning for Delegate in person meetings to resume sometime this year. Most AKC staff will hopefully be able to return to their offices starting in June.

AKC Webinar—Detection Dog Task Force

The AKC Detection Dog Task Force's is hosting a webinar featuring updates about AKC Reunite's *Adopt a K-9 Cop* matching grant program and the United States Police Canine Association, Inc. (USPCA).

AKC Reunite's Adopt a K-9 Cop Matching Grant Program matches funds (3:1) to help local AKC clubs to purchase police K-9s for local police departments throughout the United States. To date, 26 Adopt A K-9 grants have been awarded to law enforcement departments in AL, CA, CO, CT, FL, GA, IN, NC, OR, PA, SC, and WA, with more planned.

The USPCA is the newest organization to be associated with the AKC. USPCA is the nation's oldest and largest police K-9 organization.

The online event will take place Wednesday, July 14, 2021 at 7:30pm ET. The session will last less than an hour.

Registration is required. At registration, participants will have the chance to submit up to three questions for discussion during the session.
