Please remember not everyone "suggested" can be placed on a panel due to a variety of reasons, however, club members input is given priority. We do work with our "sister" cluster clubs and also have a policy not to hire the same judge for the same show two years in a row. Since we do share judges with the other cluster clubs, we tend to try to hire judges approved for several groups, if possible, to control expenses through judge sharing. If anyone in our club is newly provisional in new breeds or thinking you may be soon, you must let Mary Ellen Macke know in order to be included in a future panel. The new judges lists are not necessarily being monitored, just an FYI reminder. If you know of someone who may be provisional in their first group, non member, etc, to recommend, also let Mary Ellen or the group leader know as they are always seeking provisional judges for AKC requirements.

AKC's News

A change to the Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 16, Section 2—Championships, was adopted at the September Delegates Meeting. The rule was amended to provide the opportunity for class dogs placing 2nd, 3rd, or 4th in the regular group to be awarded Championship points. Language was added to define how any Championship points to be awarded would be calculated where a class dog placing 2nd, 3rd, or 4th in the group competition would receive the greatest number of Championship points earned in the breeds from the same group excluding any breed which received a higher placement in the group at the same event. This change is effective January 1, 2023.

The Atlanta Kennel Club sponsored a Meet The Breeds Event for Juniors and PeeWees was held on October 1st at Alchemy Dog Training in Marietta. Many thanks to Leslie Chambers and Sandy Weaver for organizing this event, and to all the members and friends that brought dogs and presented their breeds to the participants.













September 2022 Delegate Report

The September Delegate Meeting was held on September 13,2022 in Newark, N.J.

The election was held to fill vacancies for the Delegate Standing Committees. This is done annually at the September meeting.

The Delegate Body voted on 5 By-Law proposed Amendments and 9 proposed Amendments of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Results are attached. *

Ashley Jacot, Director of Education gave a presentation of the new initiatives her department is working on. This department oversees the Canine College, Public education, curriculums for schools, AKC Webinars, Judges Education, the AKC Library and Archives to name a few. As well as assisting other departments to produce educational content on a variety of topics. Coming soon: Stewarding 101 which will include how to prepare for your stewarding assignment and how to run the ring. They are working on The Puppy Pack for 2023, the Patriotic Puppy Program, the Puppy Preschool which will be presented in an 8-week series.

One program that has been very successful is Bailey's Book Club which provides books to Title One schools. They pair AKC clubs with a school in their area. So far over 3,000 books have been distributed to 300 schools.

Events are trending up each month and now out pace pre-covid numbers. To date 12,442 AKC events have been held which is an increase of 1,766 events over 2021.

Litter registrations to date are 167,287 with an increase of 2% over 2021. Dog registrations to date are 389,514 slightly down as compared to 2021.

The task force developing The AKC Pure Bred Preservation Bank is making good progress as they continue to develop a website, policies and practices. They are now incorporated, have a Constitution and By-Laws, Officers and Board selected.

The Pet Disaster Trailer project under the direction of AKC Reunite will celebrate the 100th trailer deployment since inception this year. The Adopt a Canine Cop program celebrated the placement of 200 Canine Officers this year. A truly outstanding accomplishment.

The National Police canine games were held in Valdosta, Georgia last week which was presented by AKC and the National Police Canine Association. This is a very significant alliance that has been fostered by AKC and the Detection Dog Task Force.

The next Delegate meeting will be held in December in Orlando, Florida.
