"Protecting Our Future: Legislative Issues to Watch"

Presented by Patty Van Sicklen, Regional Manager for AKC Government Relations

As Regional Manager for AKC Government Relations, Patty Van Sicklen evaluates proposed legislation and communicates its potential impact to legislators and stakeholders; works with state and local lawmakers to craft reasonable, enforceable canine legislation; and conducts regional grassroots education and outreach.

Judges' Selection Committee

Please contact committee members from the appropriate groups to suggest judges for consideration by the selection committee which meets several times during the year. Please remember not everyone "suggested" can be placed on a panel due to a variety of reasons, however, club members input is given priority. We do work with our "sister" cluster clubs and also have a policy not to hire the same judge for the same show two years in a row. Since we do share judges with the other cluster clubs, we tend to try to hire judges approved for several groups, if possible, to control expenses through judge sharing. Members provisional for any breeds are also given a priority as well as suggestions from specialty clubs for their supported entries.

AKC News

Sheila Goffe from the AKC Government Relations Department reported to the AKC Board that they have updated the "AKC Economic Benefits of Dog Shows" information, and they have also included flyers for each state. The new surveys done in late 2021 show that an exhibitor spends \$863 in a local community during a dog show weekend. This is an increase of approximately \$200 over previous, similar surveys conducted in 2012 and 2015. For Georgia, that means that a show weekend injects about \$2.15 million into the local economy. The Georgia flyer also highlights the Disaster Trailers, the K-9 Cop Grants, and the Canine Health Foundation. 




