### AKC Delegate's Report—July 2023 Meeting

CMS Upgrade Project- In November, the decision was made to move ahead with shifting the Competition Management System to the updated PowerBuilder web-based platform. This is a two to three-year project and the Board gets regular updates.

Using an outside consulting firm to assist, the work started in November 2022.

The transition has been completed in a staged environment, verified and deployed on June 6, 2023 for Operating Staff usage. This is a major milestone in the CMS Upgrade Project. This included automated letters for Agility, Rally and Scent Work, an upgraded Judge Panel Management System, and three reports to assist conformation Judges. The next five enhancements were outlined to the Board.

Total Revenues of \$44.3 million are lower than budget by 1.6%. Registration related revenues exceeded budget by 6 %.

Controllable Expenses total \$33.1 million and are lower by 6% of budget. 2023 YTD Litter Registrations are 3% ahead of budget and 6% lower than 2022 YTD. YTD Dog Registrations are 7% lower than budget and 15% lower than 2022 YTD. Events and Entries are up 7% and 2% respectively.

The 2023 Nominating Committee elected by the Board are delegates, Patti Strand, Chair, Marilyn DeGregorio, Florence Duggan, Don James, Barbara Shaw, alternates, Terrie Bree, and Douglas Johnson.

The Board voted unanimously to approve the request by the Delegate Advisory Committee to increase the quarterly reimbursement to Delegates that serve on committees from \$200 to \$400 and to evaluate the reimbursement level every five years. The Board also passed and Expense Reimbursement Policy to adhere to current IRS rules.

Two new breeds were approved for acceptance into FSS- Large Munsterlander, and the Thai Bangkaew Dog.

AKC Government Relation is currently tracking more than 1.400 local, state and federal bills. Federal priorities include potentially harmful bills such as the Puppy Protection Act (HR 1624) and Goldies Act (HR 1788), as well as positive measures such as the Healthy Dog Importation Act (HR 1184/S502) and the Beagle Brigade Act (HR 1480/S759).

Dr. Mary Burch presented recent updates of the AKC Therapy Dog Program. The total number of AKC Therapy Dog Titles to date are 18,516, an average of 1,500 titles per year. AKC has a positive working relationship with 250 therapy dog verification organizations.

The Board reviewed a proposal to modify Chapter 16, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows, which would allow specialty clubs the option to offer awarding a three-point major to Reserve winners, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winner's sex totals a least twice the number for a five-point major at any special-ty show for its breed. This will be read at the September Delegate Meeting and for a VOTE at the December Delegate meeting. The Board approved this recommendation.

The Staff provided updated wording that will be included in the AKC Show Manual to describe ramps and tables. This includes guidelines for construction and dimensions.

Rules Applying to Dog Shows Chapter 2, Section 8. Staff provided an overview of the rules requiring specialty clubs to obtain permission form the Parent Club to hold specific events.

In 2022 Specialty clubs held the following number of events:

Conformation Specialties 2,422

Basset Hound Field Trials 23

Dachshund Field Trials 81

Pointing Breed Field Trials 239

Spaniel Field Trials 14

Since 2015 only Conformation Clubs have utilized the appeal process outlined in the rule. 8 Specialty clubs have not been able to obtain permission the Parent Club which has resulted in appeal. Of those 8, 4 appeals were approved and 4 denied.

In the first six months of 2023 AKC has received a total of 130 broadcast hours on ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPN News, a 44% increase over 2022. The 130 hours represents 69 total broad casts, an increase of 25 broadcasts compared to the first six months of 2022.

The Board voted to modify the following:

### AKC Delegate's Report—July 2023 (continued)

AKC Tracking Regulations, Chapter 2, Section 19 to state that recording devices are not allowed on the tracking field and that dogs may wear googles.

Field Trial Rules and Standard Procedures for Pointing Breeds, Chapter 14, Section 19, to remove a condition regarding the Gordon Setter Club of America's Walking Gun Dog Championship, that states if the Parent Club fails to hold its traditional horseback National Championship the right to hold the walking event may be rescinded by the Performance Events Department. This will be read at the September Delegate meeting and for a VOTE at the December meeting.

Lure Coursing, Change Muzzle Description. Dogs must be able to open its mouth to pant and breathe freely. Muzzles must be of a basket type.

Pointing Breed Hunt Tests/Field Trials-Tracking Devices, Staff does not have to approve each brand of tracking receiver, clarify that a scout may not carry a device which can be paired with a receiver, clarify that receivers when left in various locations during an event, cannot be turned on. Effective August 1, 2023.

Retriever Hunt Tests-Talking to Dog at Junior Level- Allow handlers in the junior level test to speak quietly to their dog and to be able to touch their dog for reassurance or positioning anytime during the event. Effective August 1, 2023.

### Judges' Selection Committee

Please contact committee members from the appropriate groups to suggest judges for consideration by the selection committee which meets several times during the year. Please remember not everyone "suggested" can be placed on a panel due to a variety of reasons, however, club members input is given priority. We do work with our "sister" cluster clubs and also have a policy not to hire the same judge for the same show two years in a row. Since we do share judges with the other cluster clubs, we tend to try to hire judges approved for several groups, if possible, to control expenses through judge sharing. Members provisional for any breeds are also given a priority as well as suggestions from specialty clubs for their supported entries.
