AKC News

From AKC Government Relations:

The DeKalb County [Georgia] Board of Commissioners deferred consideration of a proposed ordinance that would, among other provisions, enact litter permits and impose restrictions on breeders and individuals who sell/transfer dogs. Revisions to the proposal are in process, and it will be on the agenda October 8, 2024.

It is important for DeKalb County commissioners to continue to hear from their constituent responsible dog owners who have concerns with this vague, overreaching proposal. Breeders and hobbyists, as well as residents who may wish to acquire their next pet within DeKalb County, are urged to contact their county commissioners and state their strong opposition to the current proposal.

AKC's Title Application Portal (TAP)

AKC has developed a new online system to help make it easier for dog owners to apply for their dog's AKC title. It is called the Title Application Portal (TAP). The portal offers a fast and simple, step by step experience to apply for titles offered in Canine Good Citizen, Trick Dog, Temperament Test, Fit Dog, Fetch, Barn Hunt, Diving Dog, Disc Dog, Flyball, Virtual Home Manners, Search and Rescue and any one of the titles recognized under the Parent Club Title Recognition Program. Users will need to login or create a MY AKC Account to begin. Dog owners can see each step of their transaction complete in real-time and confirm their order.
